The 21st ifva Igniting the Sparks of Creativity Awards Calling for Entry Now

Organised by the Hong Kong Arts Centre and sponsored by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, the 21st ifva is officially launched today at the 3/F foyer of the Hong Kong Arts Centre. Guests who attended the launch to witness the ignition of creative sparks include: multi-talented artist Lai Yan-chi, popular magazine *Walgazine* creator Welby Chung, Wong Ping Animation Lab, Mable Ho who is the Head of Film Programmes of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, Hong Kong Arts Centre Executive Director Connie Lam, and ifva Director Kattie Fan. The launch event also announced the prizes and jury for all the Awards categories. This year's jurors include: renowned actor, screenwriter and director Sylvia Chang, veteran film producer Nansun Shi, Eve Tam who is the Museum Director of the Hong Kong Museum of Art, Adam Wong who directed the popular *The Way We Dance*, creative practitioner Adrian Chow, experienced film director Ying Liang, founder of 100 Most and Black Paper Lin Rixi, etc. (See Appendix 1 for the list of jurors)

Igniting the Sparks of Creativity in Everyone's Heart

The 21st **ifva** continues to commission **Wong Ping Animation Lab** to design the publicity visuals and trailers. The lab's founder Wong Ping, 18th **ifva** Awards Animation Category Gold Award winner and whose creations have been favoured by famous brands, talks about the sparks of creativity: "Everyone has some sparks of creativity deep inside. The creative ideas may fail to explode owing to all different reasons. What they need is perhaps just a 'match' to ignite the 'fuse' and spark off the explosion." **ifva** has always assumed this role of an igniter to offer different opportunities to creators of various genres. With suitable environment and support, **ifva** strongly believes that everyone can spark off creativity from within, and thus unleash the passion that will glow on screen!

Combustibles to Fuel Creativity

There are five categories under the **ifva** Awards, namely, "Open", "Youth", "Animation", "Media Arts" and "Asian New Force", receiving shorts from locally and Asia, and animations and media art works. Apart from the creative sparks from within, different "fuels" are indispensable for a powerful combustion. Attractive prizes will be given out to winners of the 21st **ifva** Awards: cash prizes totaling up to HK\$320,000 for Gold and Silver Award Winners, professional shooting equipment and software sponsored by Blackmagic Design Asia Pte Ltd, and overseas trips to broaden winners' horizons. ifva All over the City to Cultivate a New Generation of Creators

Apart from the Awards, **ifva** is also dedicated to education and grooming of new forces. **"Young Filmmakers"** programme, sponsored by WYNG Masters Award, features creative training sessions that encourage participants to express their ideas through images. Creative film education project **"All About Us"**, designed for ethnic minorities in Hong Kong, will invite filmmakers and video artists to teach skills and techniques in filmmaking. **ifva** is also working with UNICEF on the **"Believe In Zero. Make A Video"** short film project in 2015. **Community Tours** screen short films at schools and community venues all over Hong Kong, sowing the seeds of film and media arts among young people. This year for the first time **ifva** receives over HK\$6 million sponsorship from The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust to initiate the **"Jockey Club ifva Everywhere"** project, comprising a series of education and outreach programmes, plus the carnival. International Cultural Exchanges

ifva organises a number of overseas screenings every year to bring Hong Kong artists to the world. Sponsored by Pure Art Foundation, Media Arts Category Silver Award and Best Local Work winner Lau Ching-wa brings her award-winning piece "Fading Away" to Ars Electronica Festival, a top-notch international media arts festival, promoting Hong Kong works overseas apart from having fruitful exchanges. Montagut Chuen, Silver Award Winner of the Animation

Category, also went to the Annecy International Animated Film Festival for exchanges, benefiting both the artist and the local cultural scene.
